116th Congress, United States House of Representatives

**Votes completed by 12/31/2020.*

*** In order of House Roll Call Vote.*

1. **Vote #204: HR 2379 – Bulletproof Vest Grant Program Permanent Reauthorization Act – Passage.** May 14, 2019. This bill would authorize \$30 million annually for a Justice Department grant program for the purchase of armor vests for state and local law enforcement and rename the program the "Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program." Passed 400-9. *NAPO Supported.*
2. **Vote #474: HR 1327 – Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act – Passage.** July 12, 2019. This bill would reauthorize through fiscal 2090 the 9/11 Victim Compensation Fund to compensate first responders and other individuals with health conditions caused by toxin exposure due to the attacks on September 11, 2001. It would authorize such sums as may be necessary for the fund and allow claims to be filed through Oct. 1, 2089. It would also require the reimbursement of any claims previously reduced due to insufficient funds and includes a number of modifications to fund management, including to provide exceptions to a cap for reimbursement of noneconomic damages. Passed 402-12. *NAPO Supported.*
3. **Vote #493: HR 748 – Middle Class Health Benefits Tax Repeal Act – Passage.** July 17, 2019. This bill would repeal the 40 percent excise tax, known as the "Cadillac tax" on the incremental costs of employer-sponsored health care plans above certain thresholds. The tax was imposed by the 2010 health care overhaul and furis currently set to take effect at the beginning of 2022. Passed 419-6. *NAPO Supported.*
4. **Vote #505: HR 397 – Rehabilitation for Multiemployer Pensions Act – Passage.** July 24, 2019. This bill would establish the Pension Rehabilitation Administration within the Treasury Department to provide 30-year loans to multiemployer defined benefit pension plans in critical or declining financial status, to allow such plans to meet pension obligations to current retirees. It would also authorize the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation to provide financial assistance to qualifying pension plans and would appropriate such sums as may be necessary for such assistance. It would establish a dedicated Treasury trust fund for expenses of the new administration, with funding generated through Treasury Department bond sales. It would require the administration to establish the loan program by Sept. 30, 2019 and issue rules regarding the program, in consultation with the PBGC and the Treasury and Labor departments, by Dec. 31, 2019. It would require loans issued under the program to have "as low an interest rate as is feasible" and would require loan recipients to provide annual status reports to the Treasury Department. Among other provisions, it would increase a number of penalties related to failure to file tax returns and retirement plan returns. It would modify certain distribution rules for funds distributed upon an employee's death to

designated beneficiaries under multiemployer defined contribution pension plans. Passed 264-169. *NAPO Supported.*

5. **Vote #700: HR 5377 – Restoring Tax Fairness for States and Localities Act – Passage.** December 19, 2019. This bill would reduce or eliminate the existing \$10,000 cap on federal tax deductions for state and local taxes, which was established under the 2017 tax law, for tax years 2019 through 2021. Specifically, it would double the cap to \$20,000 for married couples filing a joint tax return for tax year 2019, and it would eliminate the cap for tax years 2020 and 2021. As amended, the bill would retain the cap for taxpayers whose adjusted gross incomes exceed \$100 million in a taxable year. As an offset, the bill would increase the top individual income tax rate from 37% to 39.6% and it would reduce the corresponding income thresholds at which the top tax bracket applies. The bill would also permanently increase from \$250 to \$1,000 a tax deduction for professional development costs for elementary and secondary school teachers, and it would establish a new tax deduction of up to \$1,000 for first responders, including for costs associated with related professional development courses. Passed 218-206. *NAPO Supported.*

6. **Vote #109: HR 6800 – Coronavirus Relief Package – Passage.** May 15, 2020. This bill would provide roughly \$3 trillion in funding to further address the health and economic effects of COVID-19, including almost \$1 trillion for direct aid to state and local governments; \$200 billion for a fund to provide hazard pay for essential workers; \$75 billion for a national testing program; and funding for state and federal response related to health care, education, housing, and food supply. It would extend federal funding of expanded unemployment compensation benefits through January 2021 and provide an additional round of tax rebates of \$1,200 for individuals with incomes of \$75,000 or less. The bill would provide \$540 billion for states, territories, and tribal governments and \$375 billion for local governments to address costs and economic impacts associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. It would also provide \$100.2 billion for the Education Department; over \$120 billion for federal programs and \$75 billion to states to provide housing and homeownership assistance; and over \$14 billion for nutrition programs. It would provide \$16.5 billion for the Agriculture Department to reimburse agricultural producers for losses due to COVID-19, in addition to other assistance for farmers and ranchers. It would provide \$200 billion to establish a fund providing grants for employers to provide hazard pay to essential employees at \$13 per hour above regular wages during the COVID-19 crisis. It would provide \$75 billion to the Health and Human Services Department for a national testing and contact tracing initiative and \$100 billion for HHS to reimburse health care providers for expenses and lost revenue related to COVID-19. It would increase federal contributions to state Medicaid programs and eliminate cost sharing for coronavirus treatments under Medicare and Medicaid. It would create a special enrollment period during the public health emergency for Affordable Care Act marketplace health plans and Medicare Parts A and B, and it would establish "risk corridor" programs to make federal payments to issuers of most private health insurance plans and Medicare Advantage plans. It would provide an additional tax rebate of \$1200 to individuals or \$2400 to those filing a joint return, increased by \$1200 for each of up to three dependents. It would extend through January 2021 federal unemployment compensation benefits of up to \$600 per week under previous coronavirus response legislation. It would extend through 2021 requirements for employers to provide additional sick and family leave and expand the requirements to apply to all private employers. It would extend the Paycheck Protection Program for small business loans through 2020; remove loan forgiveness requirements related to minimum amounts used for payroll costs; and establish set-asides for businesses with 10 or fewer employees, nonprofit organizations, and community financial institutions. It would provide \$45 billion for Treasury Department payment of private student loans up to \$10,000 for economically distressed borrowers, and it would provide up to \$10,000 of loan forgiveness for all federal student loans. It would expand a March 2020 provision to prohibit all evictions and foreclosures for one year and establish a temporary moratorium on consumer debt collection from consumers and debt collection from small businesses and nonprofits. It would provide \$3.6 billion for payments to states for coronavirus response related to the 2020 elections and require states to offer same-day voter registration and an early voting

period of at least 15 consecutive days. It would also provide \$25 billion to the U.S. Postal Service and \$410 million to the Census Bureau. Among other provisions, it would eliminate the existing \$10,000 cap on federal tax deductions for state and local taxes for tax years 2020 and 2021. Passed 208-199. **NAPO Supported.**

7. **House Vote 119 - HR 7120: Policing Overhaul – Passage.** June 25, 2020. This bill would establish reporting and oversight requirements related to policing data and restrict the use of certain policing practices by federal law enforcement agencies and state and local agencies receiving certain federal policing grants. It would restrict a number of policing practices by federal law enforcement agencies and state and local agencies that receive federal funding, including to prohibit the use of "no-knock warrants" to execute searches in drug cases; the use of deadly force, including chokeholds, except as a "last resort" to prevent imminent injury to an officer or another person; and the use of deadly or "less lethal" force before exhausting reasonable alternatives, including deescalation tactics. It would prohibit racial profiling by law enforcement, authorize lawsuits regarding violations of the prohibition, and require agencies to implement racial profiling training and oversight procedures. It would require the Justice Department to establish a national police misconduct registry, and it would establish a number of reporting requirements for law enforcement agencies, including on use of force, racial profiling, officer misconduct records and routine policing practices -- with data disaggregated by demographics of officers and civilians involved. It would eliminate "qualified immunity" protections for law enforcement officers by prohibiting legal defenses based on an officer acting "in good faith" or the purported absence of "clearly established" law. It would require federal law enforcement officers to use body cameras and dashboard cameras and require state and local agencies to use certain grant funding to purchase body cameras and develop protocols for their use. As amended, it would make it a crime for an officer to engage in a sexual act with an individual under custody. Among other provisions, it would require the Justice Department to analyze and recommend updates to law enforcement agency accreditation standards. It would authorize \$750 million annually through fiscal 2023 for grants to support independent investigations into police use of deadly force, including to create civilian review boards. It would authorize subpoenas by the Justice Department or state attorneys general for evidence related to potential violations of constitutional rights by law enforcement and authorize grants to states to support such investigations. It would authorize grant funding for activities related to community-based policing practices and non-police public safety initiatives. It would limit the transfer of military equipment from the Defense Department to state and local law enforcement agencies. Passed 236-181. **NAPO Opposed.**

NOTE: NAPO had several legislative victories in the House of Representatives in the 116th Congress that are not included in this report as they were passed by voice vote, which does not record how each individual member voted for the legislation. This document only tracks yea/nay votes in order that we can attribute support or opposition to members of Congress on NAPO's priority legislation and analyze their support for our positions in a meaningful way.

NAPO's priority legislation that passed the House by voice vote:

- **S. 998:** Supporting and Treating Officers in Crisis (STOIC) Act.
- **H.Amdt. 20 to Division A of H.R. 3055:** Amendment to the Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations Act to increase funding for the Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act to \$4 million.
- **H.Amdt. 59 to Division A of H.R. 3055:** Amendment to the Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations Act to increase funding for the Bulletproof Partnership Grant Program to \$30 million.
- **H.Amdt. 130 to Division A of H.R. 3055:** Amendment to the Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations Act to restore vital funding for the Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program Authorization Act.

- **S. 3607:** Safeguarding America's First Responders Act
- **H.R. 6529:** Public Safety Officer Pandemic Response Act

While there are not a significant number of bills that were passed by Congress in the 116th Congress, the importance of those that did pass is significant. The passage, and later enactment, of the Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act, the Bulletproof Vest Grant Program Permanent Reauthorization Act, and Middle Class Health Benefits Tax Repeal Act (which was enacted into law as part of H.R. 1865) are incredible, long-fought for victories for NAPO and our members.

1. **Vote #222: HR 1327 – Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act - Funding Limitations.** July 23, 2019. Senator Mike Lee (R-UT), amendment no. 928 that would limit the funds authorized in the bill to \$10.2 billion through fiscal 2029, and to an additional \$10 billion from fiscal 2030 through fiscal 2092 for the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund. Rejected 32-66. *NAPO Opposed.*
2. **Vote #223: HR 1327 – Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act – Sequestration Requirement.** July 23, 2019. Senator Rand Paul (R-KY), amendment no. 929 that would require the president to issue a sequestration order to reduce all direct spending except for certain welfare and veterans programs for fiscal 2020 through 2025 by a uniform percentage that would reduce total direct spending by \$2 billion for each fiscal year. Rejected 22-77. *NAPO Opposed.*
3. **Vote #224: HR 1327 – Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act – Passage.** July 23, 2019. This bill would reauthorize through fiscal 2090 the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund to compensate first responders and other individuals with health conditions caused by toxin exposure due to the attacks on September 11, 2001. It would authorize such sums as may be necessary for the fund and allow claims to be filed through Oct. 1, 2089. It would also require the reimbursement of any claims previously reduced due to insufficient funds and includes a number of modifications to fund management, including to provide exceptions to a cap for reimbursement of noneconomic damages. Passed 97-2. *NAPO Supported.*
4. **Vote #80: HR 748 – Third Coronavirus Supplemental Appropriations and Stimulus Package – Passage.** March 25, 2020. This bill would provide roughly \$2.3 trillion in funding to address the health and economic effects of COVID-19, including \$500 billion for Treasury Department loans and investments to support affected businesses, states, and municipalities, \$377 billion for Small Business Administration loans and grants, \$100 billion to reimburse health care providers for expenses and lost revenue, federal funding of expanded unemployment compensation benefits for up to four months, and direct tax rebates of \$1,200 for individuals with incomes of \$75,000 or less. It would provide \$500 billion for Treasury Department loans and other investments to support businesses, states, and municipalities affected by COVID-19, including up to \$29 billion for loans and loan guarantees to the airline industry and up to \$17 billion for loans and loan guarantees to businesses critical to maintaining national security. It would establish certain requirements for businesses receiving such funds, including to prohibit them from

engaging in stock buybacks or reducing employment levels by more than 10%. It would establish a Treasury Department special inspector general and a congressional oversight commission to monitor disbursement of such funds. It would also provide \$32 billion for direct grants to airlines for payroll support. It would provide approximately \$377 billion for Small Business Administration loan and grant programs, including \$349 billion for business interruption loans of up to \$10 million for businesses with under 500 employees -- borrowers would be eligible for loan forgiveness for any amounts used for payroll costs, mortgage payments, and rent or utility payments, reduced based on reductions in employee retention. It would authorize federal funding of unemployment compensation benefits of \$600 per week to individuals who are unemployed or unable to work due to COVID-19, to be disbursed by states in addition to existing state unemployment benefits, through July 2020. It would also require the Labor Department to provide 13 additional weeks of unemployment assistance to affected individuals who have exhausted other state and federal unemployment benefits and up to 39 total weeks of assistance for affected individuals not eligible for existing benefits, such as self-employed and contract workers, through December 2020. The bill would provide a tax rebate of \$1,200 to individuals or \$2,400 to those filing a joint return, increased by \$500 for each child. It would reduce the credit by 5% of a filer's gross income exceeding \$75,000 for individuals or \$150,000 for joint filers. It would provide \$100 billion for the Health and Human Services Department public health and social services emergency fund to reimburse health care providers for expenses and lost revenue related to COVID-19. It would provide \$1.32 billion for grants to health centers for coronavirus prevention, diagnosis, and treatment activities. It would require Medicare Part B to cover the COVID-19 vaccine, when developed, and require Medicare prescription drug plans to allow for fills or refills of up to a three-month supply during a public health emergency. It would require HHS to take actions to address potential drug and medical shortages and expedite certain biomedical research related to COVID-19. It would require the Education Department to suspend payments due for federal student loans through September 2020 with no accrual of interest. It would waive penalties on COVID-19-related withdrawals of under \$100,000 from a retirement plan; provide tax credits to employers equal to 50% of wages paid, up to \$10,000 per employee; allow for advance payment of emergency paid leave tax credits for employers; allow for deferred payment of payroll taxes by employers over two years; increase allowable deductions by businesses for business interest and net operating losses; and provide a temporary excise tax exception for alcohol used to produce hand sanitizer. Passed 96-0. ***NAPO Supported.***

5. **Vote #132: S 4049 – Fiscal 2021 Defense Authorization - Limit Property Transfers to Law Enforcement.** July 21, 2020. Schatz, D-Hawaii, amendment no. 2252 to the bill that would modify conditions for and limit the transfer of Defense Department property to state and local law enforcement agencies. Among other provisions, it would prohibit the department from transferring certain weapons, including bayonets, grenades, firearms or ammunition of .5 caliber or higher, tracked combat vehicles, weaponized drones and asphyxiating gases. It would add reporting and inventory requirements regarding transferred property, require the department to pause transfers to any agency subject to a civil liberties investigation and establish an interagency working group to oversee equipment transfer programs and policy. Rejected 51-49. ***NAPO Opposed.***

NOTE: NAPO had several legislative victories in the Senate in the 116th Congress that are not included in this report as they were passed by unanimous consent, which does not record how each individual senator voted for the legislation. This document only tracks yea/nay votes in order that we can attribute support or opposition to senators on NAPO's priority legislation and analyze their support for our positions in a meaningful way.

- S. 3434 : COPS Counseling Act.
- S. 3607: Safeguarding America's First Responders Act.

While there are not a significant number of bills that were passed in the 116th Congress, the importance of those that did pass is significant. The passage, and later enactment, of the Never Forget the Heroes: James Zadroga, Ray Pfeifer, and Luis Alvarez Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund Act, the Bulletproof Vest Grant Program Permanent Reauthorization Act, and Middle Class Health Benefits Tax Repeal Act (which was enacted into law as part of H.R. 1865) are incredible, long-fought for victories for NAPO and our members.
